



Dear Friends,

Our fiscal year began with great anticipation as the Child Protection Center was celebrating a huge milestone- 40 years of dedicated services in our community. Additionally, the PAWS program celebrated 10 years of support for children.



We were fortunate to have over 30 advocates take on the role of Captain and make a commitment to raise \$10,000 each for our 40th Anniversary Campaign. The goal was to raise funds for our mission without an event. The Captains succeeded by engaging their friends and family in conversations about the prevention, intervention and treatment of child abuse, a topic that is often excluded from conversations.

We continued to celebrate CPC's 40th Anniversary at the Night of Hope & Healing event and envisioned further celebrating this milestone throughout the year, culminating with a huge celebration at our Blue Ties and Butterflies event in April 2020. The Board of Directors, event committees and staff had detailed plans that would ensure this year would be a huge success. All the planning in the world would have never fully prepared CPC for what happened next: a global pandemic that effectively stopped everything as Safer at Home orders were issued across the United States. With social distancing requirements, it became evident that our signature event, which was sold out, would be cancelled. You can imagine our anxiety as we rely on this event to balance our annual budget.

It is at this pivotal point where the heart of our community shined ever so brightly. Our announcement of the cancellation was met in such a philanthropic manner. Most allowed CPC to keep their sponsorships or ticket sales even with the event cancelled. The community dug even deeper and made donations to match a lead gift made by Keith D. Monda to replace the lost revenue from our cancelled event. We are so appreciative of every gift that was made to sustain program services. Your generosity in a pandemic enabled CPC to meet the growing demand for services. CPC is thankful for a community that cares deeply for children and families in need.

Child abuse cannot be placed on a waiting list! It was essential that CPC remained open providing Prevention, Intervention, and Treatment Services. To follow social distancing guidelines and to protect staff and children, many programs transitioned to virtual services. CPC has provided more services (March -June) than we did last year in the same period.

Yes, this year has been different because of the pandemic, social distancing, virtual services and Zoom meetings. We all have had to redefine our 'new normal' and CPC is so thankful that you all still had the courage to take a stand for children. In doing so, your investment helped CPC to change lives. In the following pages we are pleased to report our successes and impact in FY 2020 through CPC's core programs.



A Brief History of the Child Protection Center



1980 - The Child Protection Center (CPC) was established. Initially provided only child abuse intervention services through the Child Protection Team (CPT).



1986 - The Sexual Abuse Treatment Program (SATP) was developed to help children & families recover from the effects of child sexual abuse.

1991 - The services of CPT & SATP were extended to children abused by a non-caregiver, a population previously unserved.



1992 - The Kid Kindness Program (KKP) began psychotherapy for children who exhibited early indications of aggressive behavior & to children who have been abused by other children.



1993 - Court ordered Children & Families Supervised Visitation Program (CFSVP) began to facilitate visits between non-custodial parents & their children.



1995 - The Personal Safety & Community Awareness Program (PSCA) was planned & service provisions began.

2010 - The Pet Advocates Working in Sarasota (PAWS) began providing support to children in court with certified therapy dogs.



2010 - CPC moves to it's current location on South Orange Avenue.



2017 - The KKP & SATP were combined to form the Child Protection Center's Therapy Program.

Celebrating 40 Years of the Child Protection Center

In 1978, the Junior League of Sarasota conducted a Community Needs Assessment, which led to the establishment of the Community Coalition of Children and Families in 1980. It would later be named the Child Protection Center. This past year marks the 40th Anniversary of CPC and its fight against child abuse. As we look back on these 40 years, we see the thousands of children who learned personal safety from PSCA, who built stronger relationships with their parents in CFSVP, whose health and safety were assessed by CPT, and who took the first steps on their path to healing in Therapy. We see the dedication of our staff and volunteers, who wake up every day determined to build a safer world for children. We see you- our supporters, advocates, superheroes- and your inspiring generosity as you protect those who cannot protect themselves. We see hope.

This past year, the heart and passion of CPC's anniversary culminated with Alisa Pettingell and her effort to create 40 CPC Captains for the 40th Anniversary, who pledged to raise \$10,000 each. We celebrated our Captains' Initiative right here on our property in December of 2019. The support received through this initiative is helping us dive into the next 40 years with the determination and fight to continue reducing child abuse in our community.

Personal Safety and Community Awareness (PSCA)



PSCA provides primary abuse prevention education to children from preschool through high school. The program also facilitates workshops for their caregivers, childcare professionals, teachers, school board staff and the greater community. PSCA has over 20 workshops, such as Internet Safety, Sexual Abuse Prevention, and Anti-Bullying. The focus is the creation of a future in which children are empowered and educated, adults are aware and equipped, and our community is a safer place for children and families. 

Intervention

The Children and Families Supervised Visitation Program (CFSVP)

CFSVP provides a safe place for children to interact with parents without the stress of being in the middle of a family argument, observing a parent who is impaired by substance abuse and without uncomfortable conversations that include adult topics. By accessing the CFSVP, the risk of violence to children will decrease. Ongoing parent and child contact, through supervised visitation, has been shown to be crucial to a child's mental health and ability to build a healthy relationship with the non-custodial parent. Over 50 Sarasota County citizens serve as CFSVP volunteers.

Child Protection Team (CPT)



CPT is a legislatively mandated program working in partnership with Child Protection Investigators of the Florida Department of Children and Families (DCF) and local law enforcement agencies in cases of children who are suspected victims of sexual abuse, physical abuse and neglect. This multidisciplinary program provides expertise in evaluating allegations of abuse and neglect, assessing risk factors, and providing recommendations for interventions to protect children. Services provided by CPT include forensic interviews, psychological and psychosocial assessments, forensic medical assessments and court testimony. CPT is the only provider authorized by the state to perform these functions in Sarasota and DeSoto Counties.

Therapy Programs SATP & KKP




The Sexual Abuse Treatment Program (SATP) and Kid Kindness Program (KKP) make up CPC's Therapy programs, which provide individual family, and group therapy services to children in Sarasota and DeSoto Counties. We serve children who have been physically & sexually abused, children exhibiting problematic sexual behaviors, and extend intervention services to the primary client's non-offending caregiver and siblings. The focus is to provide mental health support, intervention, and treatment to children and families experiencing crisis and trauma, as well as reduce child-on-child sexual abuse. Through effective trauma treatment, we restore the health, development, relationships, and the safety of children and families.

COVID-19 Response

As an essential business, CPC remained open from the very onset of the health crisis. We quickly adapted to virtual services for Therapy and Supervised Visitations while PSCA developed digital lessons on prevention and personal safety for children, families, and childcare professionals. The Child Protection Team continued to provide medical exams, forensic interviews, and child abuse assessment and intervention services in person as mandated by law. The adaptations of programming were met with major success- in the months of April-September of 2020, CFSVP had a 35.3% increase and Therapy saw a 20.74% increase in services from the same period last year. While those are wonderful accomplishments, the increase in services for the Child Protection Team was nothing short of gut wrenching. CPT saw an 18% decrease in child abuse reports from April-September as children faced months of isolation from mandated reporters; however, there was a simultaneous increase in services, particularly for sexual abuse. We want to be extremely clear- fewer reports does NOT mean that abuse was not happening. It simply means that children were not being seen by the teachers or other adults who would typically see the signs of abuse and report them. The simultaneous increase in services means that we were performing MORE services on FEWER children- this shows a serious rise in critical cases during the pandemic. The staff of the Child Protection Center worked tirelessly to protect these children as they faced increasingly risky situations due to the health crisis.

We look forward to our mission driven signature event Blue Ties & Butterflies every year. This annual event is held in the month of April, as it is Child Abuse Prevention Month. As much as we depend on this event to sustain CPC programming, the health and well-being of our supporters were far more important, and the 2020 event was canceled following the guidance from the City of Sarasota concerning coronavirus. In response to the cancellation, Keith D. Monda led donors in a matched fundraising challenge and encouraged the community to raise \$200,000 in an effort to sustain programming for the many vulnerable children that the Child Protection Center assists.

On April 1st, the would-be-date of Blue Ties, CPC held a #BlueForKids social media event. Staff, volunteers, and supporters wore blue and posted their photos online to spread awareness and support CPC safely from their homes. Although we greatly missed seeing our friends and advocates at Blue Ties & Butterflies, it was a joy to connect online and see the sea of blue on our newsfeed!

Donor Profile: Roger & Alisa Pettingell

Since their introduction to the Child Protection Center many years ago, Roger and Alisa Pettingell have become steadfast advocates for children. The Pettingells were first brought into the CPC community by Graci and Dennis McGillicuddy, who encouraged them to participate on the Advisory Board. That first meeting had a profound impact on the couple.

“When I heard the statistic indicating 1 out of 4 girls and 1 out of 5 boys will be sexually abused before they reach 18 years old, I was appalled and my heart absolutely broke,” Alisa reflected. “I looked around the room counting every fourth person, realizing that’s how prevalent this is, and I just started to cry.”

They quickly deepened their involvement with the organization with the goal of creating a diverse team of advocates to spread the message. They hosted a lunch in their home for their friends, new and expecting parents, other members of the community, and invited CPC’s Executive Director Doug Staley to speak. This created an opportunity for their circle to get in touch with the mission, many of whom have since become ambassadors, allowing the message to spread further. They are firm believers that “... your voice is as important as your checkbook. You may be unable to give, but your voice carries into the community and has direct impact through raising awareness and prevention.”

Alisa then went on to chair the 2nd Blue Ties & Butterflies, CPC’s annual gala that has raised momentous awareness and support to our mission by ending the silence and secrecy of child abuse in our community and became chair of the Advisory Board. She continued to further her dedication as CPC approached its 4th decade of service. Doug Staley commented that, “The heart and passion of CPC’s anniversary culminated with Alisa and her effort to create 40 CPC Captains for the 40th Anniversary, who pledged to raise \$10,000 each.”

“It is our responsibility to advocate and be the voice for the innocent. We must come together as a community in order to help children who are unable help themselves.”

As parents themselves, the Pettingells are particularly invested in CPC’s prevention and education services. Roger stated, “What really touches my heart is the education- to get this message out there and really give us a chance to eradicate child abuse. That’s something within our means to give them. To give them that education, that power, that self-confidence. When we had our own kids, the thought that someone could abuse my child... It just left me feeling so empty. But I have a solace in knowing that we’ve educated them. That’s what I want for everybody.”

The Pettingells have always found special significance and inspiration in the Pillar of Hope, which resides in the Child Protection Center’s lobby and resembles the children who have walked through its doors. This is particularly fitting, as CPC views the Pettingells’ advocacy as a pillar in our mission- a pillar of strength, resiliency, and above all, a pillar of hope.






Revenues by Source




Months Cash on Hand
