



One of the most impactful pieces of art on display at CPC is titled "The Missing Piece." This was done by a 15 year old girl in our therapy program. She was sexually abused by her high school coach. She was ostracized by her peers. They couldn't believe she did this to their coach. She felt completely isolated which is depicted in the far left hand corner; she is alone and cutoff from everyone else. Toward the top of the piece she depicts the abuse. Toward the top right is a self-portrait with the eyes darkened and mouth covered. She had no voice or vision for the future! The right side of the artwork was masterfully done as puzzle pieces as she is putting the pieces of her life back together. This artwork, like all art, communicates a story and depicts the real struggle and journey of this young child. You can almost hear the dialogue with her therapist as her journey unfolds, but no matter what there will always be a missing puzzle piece that her perpetrator took from her.

Her perpetrator served a five year sentence with probation. While on probation he missed curfew and was then required to serve his original sentence of 18 years. The family felt that they finally had closure. The picture is a digital scan of the original artwork and is displayed with permission. You can see the Journey of these courageous children through their artwork which is displayed throughout our building. Helping children go from victim to survivor to one that thrives is a goal of our therapy program.

A variety of giving options surrounds insurance policies including the option to give a paid-up policy or buy insurance to replace a charitable bequest.

IRA CHARITABLE TRANSFER (Donors 70 or Older)

This option gives donors the ability to contribute to their required minimum distribution for the year the gift is made and receive multiple tax benefits even when taking the standard deduction. The CPC can walk you through this process, along with your IRA administrator.




REVENUES BY SOURCE



PROGRAM EXPENSES




