Personal Safety & Community Awareness (PSCA)

PSCA provides child abuse prevention education to children, parents, and professionals in Sarasota County.

- Workshops offered for children Pre-K to High School

INTERVENTION

The Child Protection Team (CPT)

Child abuse and neglect is a **complex issue**. **CPT** is a medically directed, multidisciplinary team that evaluates abuse allegations.

- Facilitates Medical Exams & Forensic Interviews
- Evaluates risk factors to the child
- Provides intervention recommendations to Law Enforcement and Department of Children and Families

90% of child abuse victims know and trust their abuser

Children & Families Supervised Visitation Program (CFSVP)

CFSVP provides a safe, neutral space for children to reconnect with their non-custodial caregiver.

- Monitored by a trained volunteer
- Law Enforcement on site
- Overall safety & well-being of the child is top priority
